Sticker Application Instructions


This installation guide includes:


- 1 large "California" logo
- 1 small "California" logo
- 2 "A-Windsurf" logos
- 2 side zig-zag stripes
- 7 pairs of lines (yellow and blue)


Applying the Blue Stripe



- 2. Use masking tape to temporarily secure the blue stripe along the length of the vehicle. It's easier to work if you place a piece of tape at each end of the vinyl.
- 3. Once you're sure the blue stripe is straight, start applying it:
 - Apply one or more strips of masking tape from the center of the vinyl to one side.
- Peel off the backing paper (the paper with the grid pattern) and cut it at the center of the vinyl piece (along the dashed line).
 - Apply the vinyl by "pulling" it from the dashed line to the end of the piece (see images 1, 2, and 3).
- 4. Now remove the masking tape from the other half of the vinyl and repeat the process.










5. Once the blue stripe is applied, carefully remove the transfer film (the transparent sheet). Make sure the blue vinyl adheres well. If necessary, rub it firmly until it sticks to the vehicle. Applying the Yellow Stripe








- 1. Place the vinyl piece face down on a sufficiently large table so it doesn't hang over the edges.
- 2. Completely remove the backing paper.
- 3. Reapply the backing paper by aligning its edge with the edge of the yellow vinyl (see images 7 and 8).
- 4. Position the vinyl piece on the vehicle and adjust it until it perfectly aligns with the blue vinyl.






- 5. Once it's in the correct position, press the remaining transfer film firmly onto the blue vinyl. Then, carefully remove the backing paper you had placed on the yellow vinyl and slowly apply the yellow vinyl to your T3.
- 6. Gently peel off the transfer film, ensuring the yellow vinyl remains adhered (rub again if necessary).
- 7. Repeat this process until all the stripes are applied.



Applying the Remaining Stickers

The remaining sticker pieces are applied using the same method as the two-tone stripe but as single pieces, which makes the process easier.

However, since these pieces are wider, there's a higher chance of air bubbles forming. To avoid this, apply the vinyl using smooth, sweeping motions from one side to the other, working gradually in small steps.
